The Chain of Command in GWRRA starts from National, Regional, District and Chapter. These divisions have Directors along with a staff of officers. This is a volunteer organization where no one gets paid for his or her commitment. The state of Maine has three Chapters Bangor, Lewiston and Sanford. Members are assigned to a chapter nearest to their physical address but all members belong to any Chapter in any location.

Our motto is Fun, Safety and Knowledge of which we are very dedicated to. Our main focus is to have fun along with learning (knowledge) safety with motorcycles. We hold/attend many Seminars on motorcycle safety along with other courses which is all offered by trained members of GWRRA. We are advocates in having all members Certified in CPR and First Aid as well as everything about riding a motorcycle, We are promoting a Level program where the riders and co-riders take different levels of training.
